Secondary One Options Exercise

- The following groups of P6 pupils who pass PSLE are eligible to participate in the S1 Option Exercise:
 - a) Those who did not participate in DSA-Sec Exercise
 - b) Those who were unsuccessful in DSA-Sec Exercise
 - c) Those who were successful in DSA-Sec Exercise and are eligible to opt for Third Language or Option Band
- S1 option form comes with a unique password (S1 PIN) for you to submit your child's secondary school options through the S1 Internet System.

Secondary One Options Exercise

Parents may exercise their child's secondary school options via:

S1 Internet System (S1-IS)

from 24 Nov 2017, 11am to 30 Nov 2017, 3pm

or

Personally through the primary school

- 24 Nov, 11am to 3pm
- 27 to 30 Nov, 9am to 3pm
- 1 Dec, 9am to 12noon (*submission of choices only, not amendments*)

Admission to St Margaret's Secondary School

- Entry to Express Stream: Minimum score of 200
- Pupils who are offered E / N(A) option band will be allocated to N(A) stream
- Need to choose SMSS as 1st choice

- You are advised to indicate ALL the six secondary choices. The six school choices should be made in the order of preference.

Secondary One Options Exercise

Non-Participating Schools

- NUS High School (NUSHS)
- School of the Arts (SOTA)
- School of Science and Technology (SST)
- Singapore Sports School (SSP)*
- Crest Secondary School (CSS)**
- Spectra Secondary School (SSS)**

*Students who have applied for SSP are required to participate in the S1 Posting Exercise. Upon release of S1 posting results, they will seek a formal school transfer from their posted mainstream secondary school to SSP

**Students who have applied for CSS and SSS are required to participate in the S1 Posting Ex. If successful for CSS or SSS, they will be informed by letter and SMS; and will not be posted to another secondary school.

Secondary 1 Posting Results


- The posting results will be released on 21 Dec 2017.
- Parents can check their child's secondary school posting results via the following channels:
 - a) Short Messaging System (SMS) via applicant's mobile number (if provided by applicants during the Option Exercise)
 - b) S1-IS

Reporting to Secondary Schools

- All pupils (including those who are admitted via DSA-Sec) are required to report to the secondary schools they are posted to on 22 Dec 2017 at 8.30am.
- Pupils must put on full school uniform and proper shoes when reporting to secondary school.
- Pupils must bring the following when reporting to secondary school:
 - a) Student Smart Card
 - b) Report Book
 - c) PSLE results slip
 - d) Sec 1 posting notification (own print-out if applicable)

- Pupils are reminded to come back to the primary school to collect their school yearbook (if you have ordered) by end Jan 2018.
